

How to Apply for a Mozambique E-Visa

(Electronic Travel Authorization or Full Visa via <https://evisa.gov.mz>)

Who Needs to Apply?

Before starting your application, please check which of the following categories applies to you:

SADC Citizens

If you are a citizen of a **SADC** (Southern African Development Community) country *, you **do not need to apply for an eVisa**.

You are permitted to enter Mozambique for **30 days at a time**, up to a **total of 90 days per year**.

All you need is:

- A valid passport, ideally with at least 3 months of remaining validity from your date of entry
- (While 30 days may be accepted, we recommend 3 months to avoid any issues at immigration.)

*** SADC countries include:**

Angola, Botswana, Comoros, Democratic Republic of Congo, Eswatini, Lesotho, Madagascar, Malawi, Mauritius, Mozambique, Namibia, Seychelles, South Africa, Tanzania, Zambia, and Zimbabwe.

Citizens of 29 Visa-Exempt Countries

Passport holders from the following countries are **exempt from needing a visa**, but must still register online via <https://evisa.gov.mz> to receive an **ETA (Electronic Travel Authorization)**.

These travelers pay 650 MZN (approx. USD 11) administration fee and **do not require a full visa**.

If you are from one of these countries, continue with the steps below to request your **ETA**.

All Other Nationalities

If you are **not from a SADC country or one of the 29 visa-exempt countries**, you must apply for a **full visa** — but the process is done via the **same eVisa portal**.

The steps in this guide apply to you as well. The only difference is the **type of visa issued** and the **fee**:

- **9,837 MZN** (approx. **USD 150**) for a standard single-entry tourist visa

The system will automatically detect your country and apply the correct visa type and fee.

Step 1: Create Your Account

Start by visiting the official Mozambican eVisa portal:

<https://evisa.gov.mz>

Once on the site:

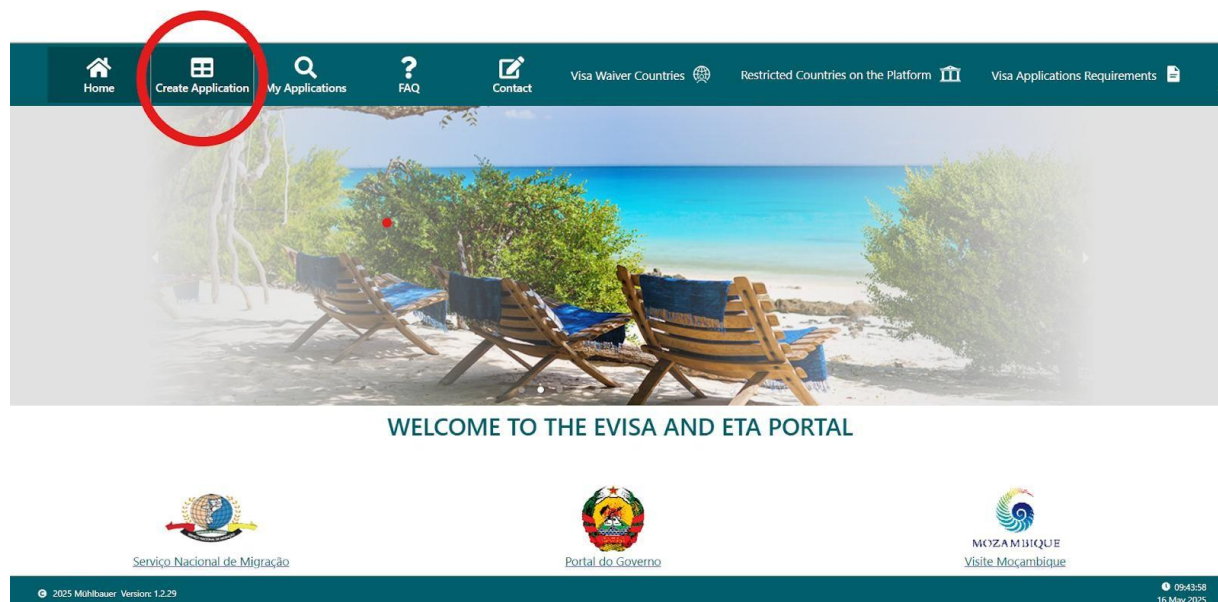
- Click the green “**Login or Register**” button
- If you’re new, click on “**Register**” at the top of the login screen
- Fill out the form to create your account

Save your username and password somewhere safe – the password reset function is unreliable, and you’ll need to log in again later.

Step 2: Start Your Application

After logging in, you’ll land on the homepage.

At the top-left, click “**Create Application.**”



You’ll then be asked to fill in the following fields:

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

Prior to your eVisa, you must obtain all required documents, following the guidelines below.

Select this Visa if you are entering Mozambique for the purpose of tourism, holiday or vacation, including to visit our beautiful beaches or tasting our amazing prawns.

DOCUMENTS

All submitted documents must be scanned, clear, legible and in one of supported formats : JPEG, PDF or PNG.

- Recent Passport size Photograph
- Passport copy, not less than 6 months validity ⓘ
- Proof of financial means
- Proof of paid hotel reservation
- Return ticket ⓘ

Payment must be done by card.

- **Nationality**
- **Passport Type** → Use “P” for a regular passport
- **Passport Type Name** → Select “Normal”
- **Visa Type** → Choose “Tourist”
- **Number of Entries** → Autofills as **Multiple**
- **Duration of Stay** → Select **30 days**

Based on your nationality, the system will show:

- Whether you need a visa
- The correct fee:
 - **650 MZN (USD 11)** for ETA
 - **9,837 MZN (USD 150)** for full visa

We recommend that even visa-exempt travelers register and receive an ETA before traveling.

Step 3: Entry Details & Personal Information

Issuance Location

This refers to where you will enter into Mozambique.

Examples: for those entering Maputo Airport, select **Aeroporto Mavalane**; or if entering through Lebombo border (coming from Komatipoort, South Africa), select **Ressano Garcia border post**. For guests flying to Vilankulo or Bazaruto, select **Aeroporto de Vilanculos**:

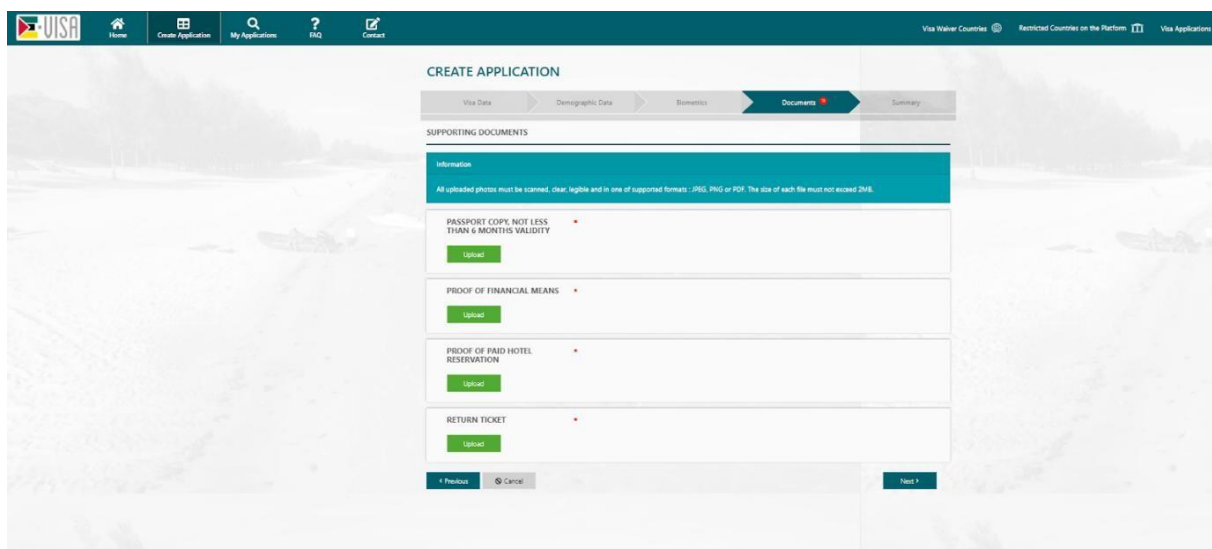
Click **Next** to proceed.

Step 5: Upload Your Documents

Have your documents ready – here's what you'll need (we suggest you bring along physical copies of all required documents to present to Immigration in case they request this):

Required Uploads:

1. **Copy of your passport**
 - Must be valid for at least **6 months** and have 3 blank pages
2. **Proof of financial means**
 - A recent bank statement
3. **Proof of paid hotel reservation**
 - We can provide this confirmation from the hotel if booked by Dana Tours – just send us your full name in text format
 - If staying with friends or family, a Termo de Responsabilidade (Declaration of Responsibility) is required by the Host and should be attached here. PLEASE NOTE: The Host will be required to submit a Boletim de Alojamento to Immigration within 5 days of the guests's arrival in Mozambique. Failure to do so will result in a fine. For more information, contact the nearest Immigration Office.
4. **Return flight ticket**
 - Required for those arriving by air



Upload Notes:

- Max file size: **2MB per file**
- File types: **JPEG, PNG, or PDF**
- You must enter:
 - **Document Date** (when it was issued)
 - **Document Number** (e.g., passport or hotel reference number)
 - **Issuing Authority** (e.g., “Germany”, “Bahia Mar Club,” “Standard Bank,” your airline etc.)

Even if a document doesn't officially have all these fields, enter something logical. These fields are required.

Click **Next** when finished.

Final Step: Review & Submit

You'll see a **summary screen** of all your details.

If everything is correct and no errors appear, click **Submit**.

Although the site says it may take up to **5 working days**, most applications are approved in **1-2 days**, and sometimes **within a few hours**.

Step 6: Receive Your ETA

Go to the **“My Applications”** section on the portal homepage.

If your application shows **“Ready for issuance”**, click **“Action”** to download your **ETA certificate**.

You'll also receive an email with the **PDF attached**.

We recommend bringing cash (USD or Euros) as sometimes the POS machines are offline and printing a physical copy of your ETA to present at immigration, as digital versions may not be accepted.
